

REACH Compliance Statement

LEM Group is fully aware of the requirements of REACH, the European Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals, which entered into force on 1 June 2007 and which specifies duties and obligations for companies in the European Union that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations or in articles .

LEM is identified as a downstream user under the REACH definitions and therefore we are not required to pre-register or register the products we supply to you. We do not manufacture or supply "substances" or "preparations" and our articles are not concerned by "intentional release of substances" during their normal use.

We believe that even though REACH is an EU regulation, LEM products are affected all around the world. Therefore LEM has decided to deploy the REACH requirements on a worldwide basis.

LEM products follow relevant requirements of the REACH regulation and LEM is eager to provide relevant information to its customers in any demand.

In accordance with the REACH directives, LEM has strengthened communications along the supply chain. Suppliers of articles and materials are required to deliver REACH compliant items to LEM and its subcontractors.

LEM assures that its products do not contain any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) from the REACH candidate list updated by ECHA on **January 15**th, **2018**.
