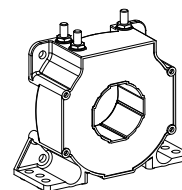


Current Transducer LF 505-S/SP22

For the electronic measurement of currents: DC, AC, pulsed..., with galvanic separation between the primary circuit and the secondary circuit.

Features

- Closed loop (compensated) current transducer using the Hall effect
- Insulating plastic case recognized according to UL 94-V0.

- $I_{PM} = 0 \dots \pm 1200 \text{ A}$
- $N_P/N_S = 1 : 3500$
- $U_C = \pm 15 \dots \pm 24 (\pm 5 \%) \text{ V}^{1)}$
- $T_A = -40^\circ \text{C} \dots +70^\circ \text{C}$
- Connection to secondary circuit on M4 threaded studs.

Safety
